Dear Parents & Carers,

As you are aware, the children have worked incredibly hard and their fun week of activities is upcoming. Please refer to the details below for specific information about each trip. Please ensure this letter is read carefully, as details differ for each trip.

Date	Trip	Drop off/pickup, lunch and clothing information	Additional details
Monday 13 th July	King George's Park, Brentwood	- Children need to be at school to the usual Y6 entrance by 8:45 prompt for a 9am coach departure - Dismissal as usual from school at the end of the school day - Packed lunch is required on this day - Children can wear comfortable active clothes	Please bring change of comfortable clothes in a back pack, including underwear, footwear and a towel, as children may get wet.
Tuesday 14 th July	Lakeside – cinema and bowling	- Children need to be dropped to Lakeside Quay, outside Hollywood Bowl, at 8:50am and handed to Miss Davis and Miss Khan where they will be ticked off. - Breakfast club children will be taken via minibus - Children will be shuttled back to school via minibus and dismissed as usual - Packed lunch is required on this day - School uniform must be worn (and leavers hoodie if child wishes)	- Snacks for cinema can be brought as part of packed lunch but we request <u>no nuts and no chocolate</u> due to allergies. Children will not buy snacks at Lakeside – no money should be brought in by the children. - No phones should be brought to the cinema, if this causes you a problem please speak to your teacher in advance.
Wednesday 15 th July	Inflatable activity day	- Drop off as usual, but the doors will open ten minutes early at 8:30, and dismissal at end of day as usual - Children will travel to Benyon Primary School via school minibus - Packed lunch is required on this day - Children can come to school in PE kit/active wear	
Thursday 16 th July	Nuclear Races, Brentwood	- Children must arrive to school by 8:45 prompt so we can register children for a 9am coach departure - Children to wear active clothes and trainers that will likely be thrown away after - It is estimated that we return to school between 4-4:15pm. We strongly advise you collect your child from the main office as they will have lots of belongings with them – if you wish for your child to walk alone, please inform	In addition to clothing worn and their lunch, children must also bring: - Change of comfortable clothing, including underwear and socks - Change of trainers - Towel - Carrier bag for wet clothing

Thursday 16 th July (sleepover)	Sleepover	- Children will have been dismissed from school following Nuclear Races. Children wishing to attend the sleepover must arrive back to school at 6:30pm to the main office having already washed at home and eaten. - A BBQ burger/hot dog will be available at the disco as a snack. - Children to wear comfortable clothes - Staff will be running activities in the evening before bed. - Children will remain at school for the school day on Friday and be dismissed at usual time.	Mobile phones for the children are <u>not permitted</u>. If your child requires a phone for walking home on Friday, this must be handed to an adult, charged and turned off, when the child arrives for sleepover. If a child is found to have a mobile on them, you will be called to collect your child and they will miss the sleepover. Items to bring: - Night clothes & sleeping bag - Hairbrush / bands - Deodorant if needed – roll on only, no aerosols permitted - Tooth brush & tooth paste - Suncream (weather permitting) for the following day's activities at school - Change of comfortable clothes for the following day x2
Friday 18 th July	School day	- Children who have not attended the sleepover will arrive to school via the usual entrance at normal time. - Children will take part in a range of fun activities at school during the day before being dismissed at normal time, following usual collection procedures. - As the majority of children will have been at school the night before, if they are packed lunch for Friday then this will need to be dropped to the school office. Alternatively, you can order your child a school dinner for this day. - Children can wear comfortable active clothes on this day	Change of comfortable clothes needed
Tuesday 21 st July	Graduation and disco	- Pupils need to arrive back at school by 5.15pm in order to take photos. The graduation ceremony will begin promptly at 6.00pm with the disco commencing at 7.00pm where parents are free to leave. - All parents to collect their children from school at 8.00pm. - Two tickets are allowed per child for the graduation and no siblings are permitted – children will bring home two tickets to be used for admission. - Dress code is smart casual – no tracksuits please!	
Friday 24 th July	Leavers' Assembly	- Parents arrive at 9:50 to main office for a 10am start. - Two tickets are allowed per child for the assembly and no siblings are permitted - children will bring home two tickets to be used for admission. - Lunch as normal

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In addition to the clothing and items listed above, children should also arrive to school have had suncream already applied, and bring a hat/refillable water bottle every day. Usual packed lunch requirements apply, including no fizzy drinks.

If you would like to order a sandwich packed lunch from the school kitchen for the trips, please complete and return the slip attached to class teachers **no later than Friday 3rd July** so that adequate lunches can be prepared. Otherwise, it will be taken that you will provide packed lunch for your child.

Due to the nature of the Nuclear Races as an adventurous activity, it is a requirement that parents/carers complete a waiver form. If this is not signed, children will not be able to participate in neither the muddy assault course nor the high ropes.
