- Well-developed induction programme to allow you to hit the ground running as a training teacher
- You will be mentored by highly skilled colleagues with innovative coaching methods
- Your training will take place locally at Dilkes Academy (13 days) and at Greenwich's Avery Campus (26 days). These are in blocks of 3 days at the beginning but lessens as the year goes on to allow you more time in your home school
