<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Awarded the gold school games mark 2024/25 for the third year running • Children's exposure to different sports has increased – children who were previously not engaged now state PE is their favourite subject • 43% (194/443) of children represented the school in a sporting event • 14 after-school clubs - 206 pupils participated • 10 sports leaders training to run sporting activity at events, lunchtimes and after school • All weather pitch has enabled sporting provision to continue throughout the year • Secondary basketball link improved engagement of key children in not just sport but in school life generally, positively affecting their attendance • 22 children attended gym trail • 30 inter school events attended this year • 5 intra competitions in which every child in the school participated
