This half term in Year 2, we will be learning:

Maths

- To solve problems involving money.
- To solve problems involving the four operations (+, -, x, ÷)
- To recognise that angles are a property of a shape.
- To identify that two right angles make a half turn.
- To identify the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.
- To identify lines of symmetry.

Science (Plants)

- To observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.
- To find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

Geography (Weather Experts)

- To explore the weather in the UK and compare it to other countries around the world.
- To recognise weather patterns in the North and South pole.
- To explore the dangers of weather.

- To name body parts
